
Age-Adjusted Female Breast Cancer Late-Stage Incidence & Mortality Overall and by Demographic Characteristics in Kansas (2012-2017)*



The five-year rate of newly diagnosed female breast cancer cases in late-stage is 42.4 cases per 100,000 females, while the five-year rate of death due to female breast cancer is about 19.2 deaths per 100,000 females in Kansas. Both incidence and mortality rates are significantly higher among Non-Hispanic compared to Hispanic females; the mortality rate is also significantly higher among African-American compared to White females.
