

# **Falls Prevention Sprint**

#### Introduction

Kansas hospitals that are ready to discover opportunities and test methods to help prevent falls with injury are invited to participate with the Kansas Healthcare Collaborative's HIIN Falls Prevention Sprint. This sixmonth sprint, conducted with <u>Jackie Conrad</u> and Betsy Lee, Cynosure Health, and other faculty, will kick off on October 24, 2018 and conclude March 21, 2019.

### Why Join?

Become a part of a statewide learning community of peers who are committed to preventing falls. Objectives for this six-month sprint are to assist participating hospitals in:

- Identifying opportunities for PDSA improvement cycles through use of the HRET HIIN Falls Process Discovery Tool.
- Applying targeted strategies for involving patients and families in fall prevention, such as validating patient/family understanding and adopting or improving the post-fall huddle process.
- Engaging in the HRET HIIN Up Campaign by designing "Get Up" strategies for engaging front line staff in preventing injuries from falls and immobility.

### Who Should Participate?

KHC HIIN hospitals actively seeking to prevent patient falls with injury and who are ready to identify gaps/opportunities and implement rapid PDSA cycles to test promising strategies.

Involve your mobility team, including those closest to the patient, those responsible for the environment, nursing leaders, quality and risk directors, physical therapy, pharmacy, and leadership. We also encourage your team to include patient/family advisor(s) who may be assisting in your hospital's falls prevention efforts.
