- What? Provides innovative and accessible infection prevention and control (IPC) education for all frontline health care workers – so they can protect their patients, their coworkers and themselves from infectious disease threats in health care.
- Why? Was developed to address long-standing gaps in IPC knowledge and practice in healthcare settings nationwide, which were highlighted because of the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Who? Intends to provide relevant information and training for all healthcare workers regardless of role nurses, certified nursing assistants, environmental services technicians, doctors, allied health professionals and other frontline staff in health care facilities in the United States.
- How? Works with a diverse group of health care, public health and academic partners, as well as state and local territorial health departments. 




