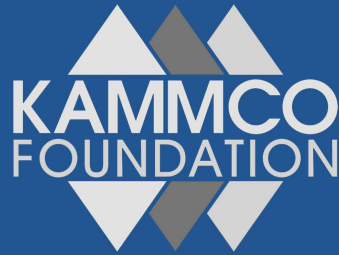

About the Leadership in Quality Awards

The Leadership in Quality Awards are presented annually to health care providers and health care organizations to recognize leadership and innovation in quality improvement and patient safety.

\$5,000 will be presented to the grand prize winner, thanks to the generous sponsorship of the Kansas Medical Mutual Insurance Company (KAMMCO) Foundation. Award of Merit winners also will be recognized.

The awards will be presented at the Summit on Quality, May 10, 2019, in Wichita: KHConline.org/summit.

Nominations are judged by an independent peer organization from outside Kansas. Award winners reflect a vision for health care that is consistent with the Triple Aim of improving the health of populations, enhancing the experience of patients, and reducing the per capita cost of care.

How to Submit a Nomination

Nominations for the Leadership in Quality Awards can be for an entire organization, a department, a particular committee, or an individual. All Kansas health care providers in any setting are eligible including (but not limited to) hospitals, physician practices, and long-term care.

Criteria for the Leadership in Quality Awards

In the space provided on the following page, please describe how the nominee meets each of the six criteria:

1. **Leadership** — clear demonstration of leadership in improving the health of the community, including the active participation of an organization's governing body, clinical staff, and administration.
2. **Patient Centeredness** — application of patient and family engagement strategies that support involvement in all aspects of patient care as well as planning and decision making for the organization.
3. **Process Measurement** — documentation of information and analysis of standardized and reliable process measures to demonstrate sustainability and ability to produce results over time.
4. **Resource Management** — management of human resources in a way that reflects a commitment to achieving quality improvement goals and ensuring patient safety.
5. **Community/population health** — identification and collaboration with community/population health-based organizations to address health needs and effectiveness of programs to meet those needs.
6. **Culture Change** — demonstration of ongoing process management and improvement efforts that prioritize patient safety and quality throughout the facility.
