The Summit on Quality is presented by the Kansas Healthcare Collaborative and the Kansas Foundation for Medical Care. The day-long educational summit features two national keynote presenters, four breakout sessions and numerous poster presentations. The breakout sessions and poster presentations are selected through a competitive review process and are an opportunity to spotlight successful quality improvement efforts achieved by Kansas providers.

The Summit on Quality invites participants including physicians, health care executives, clinic managers, quality and risk managers, infection preventionists, patient safety professionals, nurses, and other health care stakeholders from across Kansas to share their experiences in quality improvement and patient safety in their organizations.
